Re-usable paper towels – A Beautiful Things designed pattern

Materials required:

Old towelling
Scrap fabric squares (polycotton or cotton)

Cutting guide:

Cut squares to your required dimensions minimum 9" (you will lose ½" once sewn together)

Use a ¼" / Edge of presser foot seam allowance throughout unless stated otherwise. Seam allowance is included in the pattern.

Instructions:

- 1) Cut your desired sized square from both towelling and fabric (cut as many as you wish to sew in one go)
- 2) Place a fabric square right sides together with a towelling square
- 3) Clip or pin around all 4 sides
- 4) Stitch round all 4 sides leaving a 3" opening in one side
- 5) Remove the bulk from the corners and turn in the right way
- 6) Press well turning in the opening raw edges to the inside and using plenty of steam to flatten the edges and corners
- 7) Top stitch around the whole square closing the hole
- 8) Attach poppers (2 male to the left on the fabric side & 2 female to the right on the towelling side)
- 9) Admire your finished product and take some pics
