Snap purses – A Beautiful Things mini course & pattern

Materials required:

100% Quilting cotton 1 x fat quarter of outer fabric and 1 x fat quarter of plain contrast lining.
A small piece of felt or wadding and scraps of quilting cotton for the handles. Matching threads & a metal tape measure.

Cutting guide:

Outer – 9" wide x 12" deep
Wadding/felt - 9" wide x 12" deep
Lining – 9" wide x 16" deep
Tabs/handles – 3" wide by 4" deep
Tape measure – 7 ½"

Use a ¼" seam allowance throughout unless stated otherwise. Seam allowance is included in the pattern.

Instructions:

- 1) Make the tabs as per video instructions
- 2) Fuse wadding to main outer panel with 505 spray or baste in place
- 3) Centre tabs onto outer panel on both ends and baste in place with a 1/8" seam allowance
- 4) Place main outer and lining panel right sides together and stitch along both narrow edges
- 5) Turn in the right way and press, leaving 1" of lining fabric on show either end of the main outer panel (this will form your snap fastener casing)
- 6) Top stitch, lifting up the handles to sew underneath
- 7) Add duct tape or electrical tape to the sharp ends of the tape measure to stop the measure cutting it's way through the fabric
- 8) Slide the tape measure into the channel curved side outermost
- 9) Fold wallet wrong sides together (lining-lining) and sew down both sides with a 1/8 seam allowance
- 10) Turn wallet right sides together and sew again with a ¼" seam allowance being careful to avoid the tape measure
- 11) Turn in the right way and press to finish.
