Mini Pouch/Earphone holder – A Beautiful Things mini course & pattern

Materials required:

100% Quilting cotton

½" D ring (alternative would be a keyring loop or skip this part if you don't want one)

Ribbon or cord 28"

Spring loaded toggle (optional)

Cutting guide:

Outer 10" circle template required FOLLOW the video before cutting out

Lining 10" circle template required FOLLOW the video before cutting out

D-ring tab Width of D ring x 4 by 2"

Use a ¼" seam allowance throughout unless stated otherwise. Seam allowance is included in the pattern.

Instructions:

- 1) Follow the video guide and cut out your outer and lining
- 2) Place outer right sides together
- 3) On the long edge mark ¾" down and then another ½" down then clip long edge
- 4) Place lining right sides together
- 5) Mark approx. 2" down and a further 2" down then clip long edge
- 6) Sew lining down the long edge leaving an opening between the marks
- 7) Press the D-ring tab in quarters width ways and top stitch the long edges with a 1/8" seam allowance
- 8) Fold around the D-ring and stitch in place as close to the D-ring as your presser foot will allow
- 9) Place D-ring tab between the layers of the outer approx. ¾" below the opening
- 10) Sew outer down the long edge leaving an opening between the marks
- 11) Press the seams open on both outer and lining
- 12) Top stitch around the opening on the outer with a 1/8" seam allowance
- 13) Place outer and lining right sides together and sew around the outside edge
- 14) Take pinking shears or clip into the seam allowance all the way around
- 15) Turn in the right way and press well
- 16) Close the opening in the lining
- 17) Topstitch all the way around the outside edge with a ¼" seam allowance and again ¼" from the edge to form channels
- 18) Thread cord or ribbon into the channel and add a spring-loaded toggle if required
