Scrappy fabric quilted pouch

This pattern was designed in-house by Beautiful Things.
If you use it to 'make to sell' please be sure to credit it's design.

Materials required

½ metre of wadding
Scrap quilting cottons as per cutting guide below
16" zip

Cutting guide

Wadding (Cut 2) 16 x 16
Scrap strips (Cut x 16) 10.5" long x 2.5" wide
Base panels (Cut x 2) 16" long x 6" wide
Optional strap 20" x 2"
Zipper tabs (Cut x 4) 2" x 2"
Lining (cut during bag creation but will be roughly 16" x 16" **DO NOT CUT** before)

Instructions

- 1) Place 1st strip onto wadding and lay 2nd strip RST and stitch in place
- 2) Press back strip, lay 3rd strip RST and sew
- 3) Repeat until all 8 strips are added.
- 4) Press and quilt
- 5) Repeat steps 1 – 4 on second side
- 6) Square up top edge
- 7) Draw a line 9.5" from top edge
- 8) Lay base strip along line and sew in place
- 9) Press back and quilt
- 10) Square up both panels to match (Approx. 16" x 16")
- 11) Cut 2 x lining panels to match size of outer panels
- 12) If you want a strap, press lengthways wrong sides together into quarters and top stitch down the open edge
- 13) Baste in place raw edges to raw edges with strap laying in on the outer 3" down from top edge of bag on 1 side
- 14) Sew 2 zipper tabs RST around the zipper approx. 1cm away from stopper
- 15) Cut back excess zipper, press back fabric and top stitch

- 16) Measure 13.5" from tab and mark + mark ¼" further out towards zipper pull
- 17) Open Zipper, place raw edges of other 2 tabs along the outer line and stitch in place, cut back excess zipper, press back fabric and top stitch.
- 18) Trim up zipper tabs in line with edges of the zipper tape
- 19) Position zipper on top of the outer and line up so equal amounts of tab are on each side. Square up if needed
- 20) With lining RS up, place zip WS down, place outer RS down sandwiching zip in between each layer
- 21) Sew with a regular foot, press back and top stitch
- 22) Repeat steps 19 – 21 with other side
- 23) OPEN ZIP
- 24) Clip up with RS together, lining to lining and outer to outer. Pay attention to base seam and fold zipper in towards the lining
- 25) Sew around the outside of the bag all the way (leaving no opening in the lining)
- 26) Draw 2.5" square on all 4 corners from the stitch line.
- 27) Cut out all 4 corners
- 28) Box the 2 outer corners and 1 inner corner by bringing bottom and side seams RST and stitching
- 29) Trim off any excess strap if you have one
- 30) Turn in through 1 lining corner, poke out tabs and check the bag works as it should
- 31) Close hole in lining
- 32) Ta-Da you are done!
